Using Your Templates

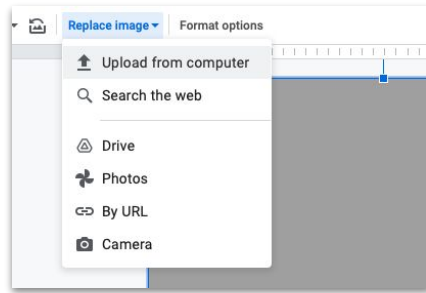
Follow these instructions for the templates above. They are formatted in sizes for Stories, Posts, and Email.

1

Make a copy of the template you need by clicking on one of the links listed on slide 3.

Select the gray background image and click “Replace Image” > “Upload from Computer.”

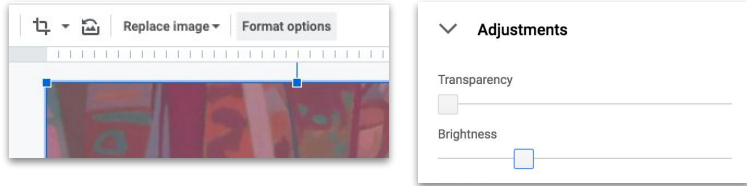

Upload a hi-res background image from the show. Recommended size: minimum 2000px height. To edit the placement of the image, right click the image, and select “Crop Image.”

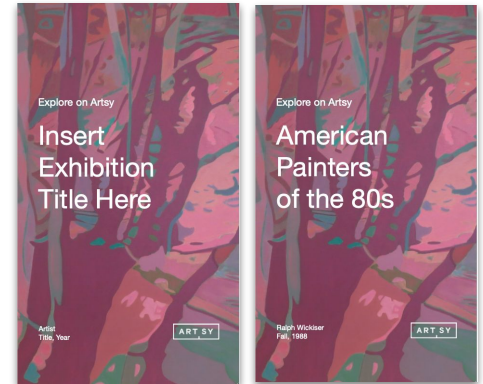

If the text is not readable, select the image, click “Format Options” and decrease “Brightness” under “Adjustments” on right.

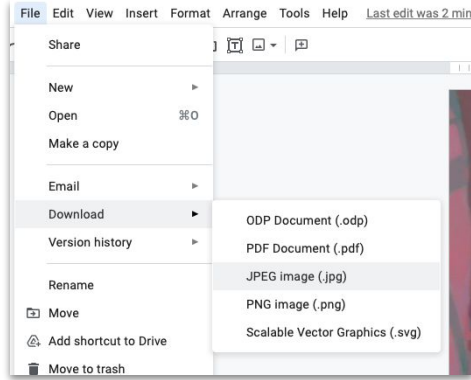
Follow the prompts in the placeholder text and type in your text as you wish for it to appear. Make sure to include image credit and exhibition start and end dates where applicable.

Download and save your newly created asset: “File” > “Download as” > “JPEG image.” This is the last step for making Email and Post assets.
